

> has grown over the years from an event for four Erindale teams to one hosting 54 teams in 2015.



A big thank you to the many tireless volunteers who make this event such a success every year and certainly ensure that the Festival theme - Every Child is a Winner - is continued!





winners of the **GTHL A Championships**




Rule Changes

At the MHL's annual AGM a number of changes were made to the rules. Most were house keeping or bringing MHL rules inline with GTHL or OHF guidelines. However, please note there are some that may affect you as a player, a coach or a parent.

- 4.05 The rule added a clause **requiring a minimum of 6** rostered players to be participating before an affiliate player may be used.
- **Body checking removed from Minor Bantam A;** only premitted at Bantam A, Minor Midget A, and Midget
- 9.02 Rule removed to allow Gold teams to be convened to ensure appropriate competition.
- 14.10 In the regular season *Midget and Midget Jr will be* allowed one time out per team per game.
- 29.03 Added *a fine for teams under 15 players* and if they do not have league approval will default games until roster is accepted or reaches 15 players.
