## Referee's Corner

1. What happens when the puck goes off an attacking player's skate and into the goal? What does the Referee consider when making the call?

#### Answer:

Did the attacking player kick (pendulum type motion) the puck into the goal?

If yes, NO GOAL

Did the puck deflect off the attacking players skate and into the goal?

If yes, GOAL



### 2. Hockey Canada Rule 10.7

Hockey Canada Rule on stick infractions (Stick infractions are penalties that involve the use of a player or goalie's stick in a manner that is outside of the rules of hockey.

Some stick infractions are treated more seriously as they can have real potential of causing injury, while others are mostly annoying, defensive measures to slow down or impede opponents).

Any player who receives 3 stick infractions in the same game at any time during the game will be given a Game Ejection. OHF code GE56

Those penalties include High Sticking, Butt Ending, Slashing, Cross Checking and Spearing.



### FIRST SHIFT **GEARS UP**

On two consecutive weekends in early November, 90 new First Shift participants hit the ice at Tomken Arena to participate in the second year of this introductory hockey program hosted by the Mississauga Hockey League. Created by Hockey Canada and Bauer Hockey,

the program aims to support local organizations like the MHL, assist in removing perceived barriers to families (cost, time commitment, safety and competitiveness) and inspire more kids to play hockey. The overall goal is to show that hockey is

fun, and to dispel myths about the high cost and safety issues.

The MHL ran First Shift in 2014-15 with a Second Shift continuation. Of the original 45 enrollees, 33 continued onto the Second Shift component which continued skills development for half of the session followed by a mini-game. Of the 45, over 60% enrolled with a hockey association for the 2015-16.

Each on-ice session is led by volunteers from the MHL Board of Directors and MHL Associations.
