We have many volunteer opportunities during the event weekend and leading up to it.

PRE-EVENT PROMOTIONS: 2-6 people

Distribution of posters and pamphlets - place event posters in rinks, schools, public areas, etc.

CHECK IN – 20 people + staff

Friday, June 9, 9 am – 7 pm

All information will be provided to you in a training session.

You will have a list of registered teams by division and will check for ID and collect signed waivers as team members come through the line. This is also where we hand out participant t-shirts, player packs and any water bottles or balls if purchased. Some teams may add or change players to their roster. Proper forms & signatures will be required. Fees to be collected for additional team members. Note Maximum roster size is 9 players for all divisions; the ONLY exception to this rule is in the UPS Corporate division.

SITE SET UP- 15 people + staff

Thursday, June 8 and Friday June 9, 11am-9pm

Mississauga Hershey Centre

Hanging banners, measuring and lining rinks, setting up tables and chairs, building nets, other set-up requirements as needed.

MASTER SCOREBOARD – 4 people

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11 (8am – 8:30pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

Volunteer duties include score sheet collection, updating scoreboards, distributing score sheets to referees, answering general inquiries about rules, scheduling, playoffs, etc.

Volunteers assigned to work in the Scoreboard area should be smart, mature, reliable, responsible, and possess good communication skills. Their job description will include interacting energetically with participants, parents, and other spectators throughout the entire tournament weekend.

SATURDAY MORNING CHECK IN – 6 people

Saturday, June 10 (7am – 1pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

Most of the teams will be from out of town and who were therefore unable to attend Check-In on Friday

EQUIPMENT RENTALS – 2 people

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11 (7:30am – 8pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

At this station, volunteers will be signing in and out goalie equipment for the day; collecting contact information and making sure all equipment is returned immediately after their game. No fees are collected - however, we ask participant to leave a credit card number in the event the equipment is not returned.

THIRST STATIONS- 2 stations x 3 people per station (6 total per shift)

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11 (2 Shifts: 7:30am – 2pm AND 2pm – 8:30pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

This is where the sports drink will be mixed and participants will come to fill up their water bottles.

Mixing and serving sports drink will be a very busy job, and require the full time attention of capable volunteers throughout the entire event. Some lifting required.

RINK MONITOR- 1 per every 5 rinks (estimated 12 total)

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11, (7:30am – 8pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

This is a role for a confident individual familiar with Play On! rules and format of the event. You will be back up support to a referee/official. Challenges to rules often arise during this event and you will be dealing with players, parents who may disagree with play, rules etc.

SECURITY – 4 people minimum

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11

Mississauga Hershey Centre (8am – 8pm)

Ideally these will be men and women that have a physical presence. They have no legal authority, and assist our staff/hired duty officers and in reality serve as a very effective deterrent to any raucous behavior that may develop during the event. This role is essential for the integrity of the tournament as they are the eyes and ears for staff members who can't be everywhere at all times.

GREEN TEAM – 8 people minimum

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11 (8am – 8:30pm, can be scheduled in shifts)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

Volunteers make sure the event site is kept clean from garbage and recyclables at all times.

Restocking toilet paper in Porta-Potties, paper towel at hand washing stations, emptying garbage, etc. as required. Supplies provided but you may want to bring your own gloves and garbage pick-up stick.

CLEAN UP & EVENT TEAR-DOWN – 10 people

Sunday June 11 (Noon – 9pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

These volunteers are required on Sunday only and will assist staff in the removal and rolling up of banners and the clean-up, take down, packing of trucks, and organization of all event materials and assets.

RUNNER & FESTIVAL HOSPITALITY – 4-6 people

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11 (8am – 8pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

This involves many tasks - such as ball distribution, vendor support, water/meal distribution to refs, etc. May involve timekeeping, scorekeeping, rink monitoring, promotional distribution, operations & rink maintenance. This role is very important for the continuous flow of the event!

SCOREKEEPERS – 1 per rink if available (estimated 60 total)

Saturday, June 10 and Sunday June 11, (8am-8pm)

Mississauga Hershey Centre

You will be keeping score and running a stopwatch for each 40-minute game.

Scoresheets are provided – attention to the game is essential to keep score.

Pregame – ensure you have the proper score sheet for the game at hand and all players sign in on the back of the scoresheet.

Postgame – ensure the ref and both team captains agree on the final score and sign the scoresheet.

Remind the winning team to deliver the scoresheet to Master Scoreboard immediately.

Running an electronic score clock will be assigned at “Feature Rink” only.
