## **GUIDELINES:**

- Nominations for Hall of Fame inductees can be submitted by an Association directly or by an MHL Director. If submitted by an MHL Director, the nomination must be endorsed by an Area Association.
- 2. Nominations must be submitted by March 1<sup>st</sup> of the current playing season.
- 3. Nominations must be submitted in writing to the MHL Office (to then be forwarded to the applicable MHL Committee), identifying the following information regarding the nominee:
  - Date
  - Who is submitting the nomination for consideration
  - Length of service (20 years minimum) within the Mississauga Hockey League (please indicate the years)
  - Explain how this person is well known to the Mississauga Hockey League either as a coach, player, executive, Association positions held, years of service, etc.
  - Explain how this person has made an outstanding contribution to the Mississauga Hockey League. Criteria you should look for might include:
    - A specific event or program that supports our purposes and objectives
    - Demonstrates a consistent character that exemplifies a role model, ambassador, emissary, or mentor over a long period of time
